


Flow Chart for the institution ensures effective curriculum delivery through a well-planned and documented process:



11. The examination fees for each B Test II examination and also the practical examination shall be as prescribed by the University from time to time.
 12. An examinee who is successful at any of the First, Second, Third and Final B Test II examinations under this Ordinance and who obtains 75% or more marks in aggregate shall be placed in the First Division with Distinction, those securing less than 75% but getting 60% or more shall be placed in the First Division and all other successful examinees shall be placed in the Second Division.
 13. (i) The scope of the subjects shall be as indicated in the syllabus.
(ii) The medium of instruction and examination shall be English.
 14. The provisions of Ordinance No. 7-A relating to condonation of deficiency of marks for passing an examination shall apply to the examinations under this Ordinance.
 15. An examinee who does not pass or who fails to present himself/herself for the examination shall be eligible for remission to the same examination, on payment of fees and such other fees as may be prescribed.
 16. An unsuccessful examinee who obtains minimum pass marks in a subject/subjects (paper and/or practical) may, in his/her option be exempted from appearing in that subject/subjects (paper and/or practical) at a subsequent examination, if he/she passes in the remaining subjects, he/she shall be declared to have passed the examination and shall be awarded a division by virtue of addition of fresh marks obtained by him/her.
 17. As soon as possible after the examinations, the Executive Council shall publish a result of the examinees. The result of all the examinations shall be classified as per (12) above and the merit list shall be notified as per Ordinance No. 6.
 18. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Ordinance, no one shall be admitted to an examination under this Ordinance, if he/she has already passed the same examination or equivalent examination of any Summary University.
 19. The examinees who have passed in all the subjects prescribed for all the examinations under this Ordinance shall be eligible for award of the Degree of Bachelor of Textile Engineering, in the prescribed form signed by the Vice-Chancellor.

*** ORDINANCE NO. 1 OF 1985.**

An Ordinance to provide for incentive marks for N.C.C., N.S.S. Games & Sports & other extra curricular activities of collegiate students.

Whereas it is expedient to frame an ordinance in respect of addition of incentive marks for participation in N.C.C., N.S.S., Games & Sports & other extra curricular activities to examination marks of collegiate students for the purposes hereinafter appearing, the Executive Council is hereby pleased to make the following ordinance:

1. This Ordinance may be called ordinance relating to addition of incentive marks for N.C.C., N.S.S., Games and sports and other extra curricular activities to examination marks of collegiate students.

* As accepted by the Executive Council, dated 19-4-1985, and amended by Ordinance Nos. 7 of 1987, and 8 of 1990.



2. This Ordinance shall come into force with effect from the summer 1986 examination.
 3. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in any of the ordinances for undergraduate examinations in any faculty except the Post-Degree Examinations such as B.Ed., B.P.Ed., LL.B., B.L.Lib., etc incentive marks for N.C.C., N.S.S., Games & Sports & other extra-curricular activities shall be awarded to the collegiate students in undergraduate examinations in all the faculties as per Appendix to this Ordinance.
 4. A student may be given a maximum of 10 incentive marks under any or all of these activities.
 5. These incentive marks shall be added to the examination marks as provided in para 6 below before application of relevant provisions of Ordinance No. 7(A) & 7(B).
 6. (i) Incentive marks shall be added to the examination marks in a subject or subjects in which the student falls short of pass marks provided such marks added are not more than 5 percent of the total marks assigned to the subject/paper/practical whichever, is a head of passing.
 - (ii) These may be added to the total marks of a candidate in case there is no shortage below pass marks in any subject.
 - (iii) These may be added both for making up short fall below pass marks in a subject or subjects and/or be added to the total marks.
 - (iv) These may be added to the total marks of science subject of B.Sc Part-I Examination of a candidate in case there is no shortage below pass marks in any subject.
 7. Incentive marks obtained by collegiate students in the session immediately preceding the main examination shall be added on the basis of a list & certificate in prescribed form to be sent by the Principal of the College before one month preceding the start of such examination.

2. This Ordinance shall come into force from the date of its approval by the Management Council.
3. In original Ordinance No.12 of 1985 in respect of "Examinations leading to the Degree of (वार्षिक उपर्युक्त) Master of Business Administration (M.B.A.) (Bi-annual Pattern) (Two Year Course) Ordinance, 1985" (hereinafter referred to as the main Ordinance), after para 5 following para be added.
4. (A) Minimum No. of Students offering Additional Specialization per Subject be 5.
- (i) The Student offering additional Specialization shall have to appear for all theory papers and submit dissertation in the subject.
- (ii) The Student will have to register himself as a regular student & will have to Pay Tuition fee Rs.6000 as well as admission fee as prescribed by the institution."
5. Para Nos. 9 to 18 of the main Ordinance be renumbered as para 10 to 19 respectively.

ORDINANCE NO.18 OF 2001

An Ordinance to provide grace marks for passing in a Head of passing and Improvement of Division (Higher class) and getting Distinction in the subject and Condonation of deficiency of marks in a subject in all the faculties prescribed by the Statute No.1K, Ordinance, 2001.

Whereas it is expedient to provide an ordinance to prescribe rules for grant of grace marks for passing in a Head of passing and improvement of division (Higher Class) and getting distinction in the subject and condonation of deficiency of marks in a subject in all the faculties prescribed by the Statute No.1K, the Management Council is hereby pleased to make the following Ordinance :-

1. This Ordinance may be called "An Ordinance to prescribe rules for award of grace marks for passing in a Head of passing and improvement of Division (Higher class) and getting Distinction in the subject and Condonation of deficiency of marks in a subject in all the faculties prescribed by the Statute No.1K, Ordinance, 2001".

2. This Ordinance shall come into force with effect from the session 2001-2002.

3. In this ordinance unless the context otherwise requires -

- A) "Act" means Matruvrat Universities Act, 1994.
- B) "Ordinance" means an ordinance made in accordance with the provisions of section 54 of the act.
- C) "Draft Ordinance" means a draft of ordinance prepared for the consideration of the competent authority.
- D) "JNU" means Joint Board of Vice-Chancellors.
- E) "Existing Ordinance" means an ordinance in operation.
- F) "Higher Second Class" means a score of 55% of aggregate marks.
- G) "AICTE" means All India Council of Technical Education.
- H) "MCI" means Medical Council of India.

PART ONE

- A.1:- Rule for granting Grace marks for passing in each head of passing (Theory Subject / paper / practical / sessional / Internal Assessment which happens to be a head of passing) to pass the examination.

Rule 1.2:-

Where an examinee is failing in one or more subjects (paper/practical/sessional/Internal assessment, which happens to be a head of passing), the examinee shall be given the benefit of Grace marks only for passing in each head of passing, to pass an examination, as shown in a table below:

Head of passing prescribed marks	Grace marks admissible upto
upto - 50	02
51 - 100	03
101 - 150	04
151 - 200	05
201 - 250	06
251 - 300	07
301 - 350	08
351 - 400	09
401 - and above	10

Provided that the benefit of Grace marks under this rule is concurrent with the rules and guidelines of professional statutory bodies at the All India level, such as AICTE, MCI, DCI, BCI, CCIM, CCH, NCTE, UGC, etc.

Provided secondly that the benefit of grace marks shall not be applicable to the examinations governed by MCI, CCH, CCIM, DCI rules.

Provided thirdly that the benefit of such Grace marks to be given in different heads of passing shall not exceed 1% of the aggregate marks in that examination.

Notes:-

- a) The provision of Grace marks under this rule shall be made applicable only after the application of Ordinance No. 1 of 1985 for incentive marks. However grace marks under this rule and incentive marks in ordinance No. 1 of 1985 and /or condonation marks under Rule No. A.4 (Part One) of this ordinance shall not be made applicable together to pass in a subject / paper / practical / sessional / Internal assessment / head of passing.
- b) Head of passing for this rule shall be as per the provisions of the Ordinance of that concerned examination.


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- c) In case the subject is divided into individual heads of passing the grace marks shall be awarded to such individual heads of passing as per assigned marks to those heads, of passing provided the total allotted grace marks to individual heads of passing shall not exceed the admissible grace marks to that particular subject.
- d) In case of Post Graduate students giving a declaration for higher division under concerned ordinance the provisions of this rule shall not be applicable.
- e) The provisions of grace mark under this Rule shall not be applicable to the candidates who remain absent for theory examination or part of it and /or practical/sessional/internal assessment/head of passing.
- f) These grace marks wherever provided under this rule shall be shown by one asterisk with added marks above the head or right side of the original marks in the Tabulation Register. However in the statement of marks these grace marks be included in the scored marks and shall be shown by the sign of one asterisk (Viz. *) above the head or right side of the consolidated marks and to be carried forward to the grand total with the same illustration.
- g) If an examinee passes the examination by grace marks under this rule a remark passes vide ordinance No.18 of 2001 shall be written in the Tabulation Register and on the Statement of marks the meaning of one asterisk be printed at the bottom as follows :

Note :* = Passes by grace marks vide Ordinance No.18 of 2001.

B. Rule for granting Grace marks for placement in a division/grade or getting higher class.

Rule II :-

An examinee who passes in all the subjects and heads of passing in the examination without availing the benefit of either grace marks under Rule A-1 (Part One) or condonation marks under Rule A-1 (PART TWO) of this ordinance and whose total number of marks falls short for securing Second Class/ Higher Second Class/First Class or corresponding Divisions/Grades by marks not more than 1% of the aggregate marks of that examination or upto 10 marks whichever is less, shall be granted the required marks to be placed in the next higher class/division/grade as the case may be.

Provided that, the benefit of grace marks under this rule shall not be made applicable if the examinee fails to secure necessary minimum passing marks in the aggregate head of passing, if prescribed in the examination concerned.

Provided secondly that, the benefit of grace marks under this rule shall be provided to those examinees and for those examinations only, where the provision of award of class/division/grade is prescribed by ordinance.

Provided thirdly that, the award of grace marks under this rule is concurrent with the rules and guidelines of professional statutory bodies at the All India level viz. AICTE, MCI, BCI, CCIM, CII/IDCI, NCTE, UGC etc.

Provided fourthly that, in case of post graduate or post degree or diploma examination, an examinee giving a declaration for higher division under concerned ordinance, the provisions of this rule shall not be applicable.

Notes:-

- a) The condonation marks under this rule shall not be made applicable for placing an examinee in first division with distinction wherever prescribed.
- b) The provisions of grace mark under this Rule shall not be applicable to the candidates who remain absent for theory examination or part of it and /or practical/sessional/internal assessment/head of passing.



internal assessment/head of passing.

- If an examinee is granted grace marks for placing in a higher division, these marks shall be shown with a sign of one plus sign (Viz.+) with added marks above the head or right side of the original aggregate marks in the Tabulation Register with a remark Division vide Ordinance No. 18 of 2001. However, in the statement of marks these grace marks shall be included in the scored aggregate marks and shall not be indicated. They are to be carried back to the lowest scored marks in theory paper.

C Rule for granting Grace marks for getting Distinction in the subject only.

Rule-III:-

An examinee who passes in all the subjects and heads of passing in the examination without availing the benefit of either grace marks under Rule A-I (PART ONE) or condonation marks under Rule A-II (PART TWO) of this ordinance and whose total number of marks in the subject/s falls short by not more than 3 (three) marks for getting distinction in the subject/s shall be given necessary grace marks up to 3 (three) in maximum two subjects, subject to maximum 1% of the total marks of that Head of passing, whichever is more, in a given examination.

Notes:-

- The post graduate students giving a declaration for higher division shall also be considered eligible to this rule.
- If these grace marks result in a fraction, it shall be converted into the next higher number.
- The provisions of grace mark under this Rule shall not be applicable to the candidates who remain absent for theory examination or part of it and/or practical/sessional/internal assessment/head of passing.
- If an examinee is granted grace marks for getting distinction, those marks shall be shown with a sign of two plus signs (Viz.+ +) with added marks above the head or right side of the original marks in the Tabulation Register with a remark Distinction vide Ordinance No.18 of 2001. However, in the statement of marks these grace marks shall be included in the scored marks and shall not be indicated. They are to be added in the grand total.

PART TWO

A Rule for condonation of marks for passing in one subject only to pass the Examination.

Rule-I :-

If an examinee fails in only one subject having passed in all the other subjects his/her deficiency of marks in such subject may be condoned by not more than 1% of the aggregate marks of the examination or 10% of the total number of marks of that subject in which he/she is failing, whichever is less. However, condonation in one subject or minimum aggregate marks of passing be restricted to maximum upto Ten marks only.

Provided that in respect of examinations governed by MCI, CCH, CCIM, DCI rules, condonation marks upto a maximum 5 (Five) to pass in a subject and examination may be allotted to an examinee. These 5 (Five) marks may be distributed in heads of passing of that particular subject as per requirements.

Notes:-

- The benefit of condonation marks under this is concurrent with the rules and guideline of professional statutory bodies at the All India Level such as MCI, MCI, BCI, CCIM, CCH, DCI, NCTE, UGC etc.


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- b) The Head/s of passing for this rule shall be as per the provisions of the ordinance of the concerned examination.
- c) In case a subject is divided into more than one head of passing, the condonation marks may be distributed amongst these heads of passing as per requirements.
- d) If condonation marks under this rule results in a fraction, irrespective of its denomination shall be converted into the next higher number.
- e) If there are more than one University examinations prescribed for a Degree/Diploma/Certificate course examination, this condonation shall be based on the maximum marks prescribed for that particular examination, which an examinee is taking at a time.
- f) In a case of post graduate students giving declaration under concerned ordinance, the provisions of this rule shall not be applicable.
- g) The provision of condonation marks shall not be made applicable to those examinees who remain absent for theory subject/paper/practical/sessional/internal assessment for an examination.
- h) The provision of condonation marks under this rule shall be made applicable only after the application of the provisions of the ordinance I of 1985 for incentive marks and thereafter the application of grace marks under Rule A-1 (PART ONE) of this ordinance. However incentive marks under Ordinance I of 1985, grace marks under Rule A-1 (PART ONE) and condonation marks under Rule A-1 (PART TWO) of this Ordinance shall not be made applicable together for passing in a subject/paper/practical/sessional/internal assessment/ head of passing or an examination.
- i) The condonation marks under this rule shall be shown by two asterisks with added marks over the head or right side of the original marks in the Tabulation Register. However, in the statement of marks the condonation marks be included in the scored marks and shall be shown by the sign of two asterisks (viz. **) above the head or right side of the consolidated marks. They are to be carried forward to the grand total or be carried backwards to the lowest earned marks of theory head as the case may be, with the same illustrations.
- j) If an examinee passes by granting condonation marks a remark passes vide Ordinance No.18 of 2001 shall be written in the Tabulation Register and on the statement of marks the meaning of the two asterisks be printed at the bottom as follows:

Note:- ** = Passes by Condonation Marks vide Ordinance No.18 of 2001

4. An examinee passes an examination with grace or condonation shall not be eligible to be placed in the merit list, any University scholarship, medal, prize or any other University award pertaining to that examination.

5. The Existing Ordinance No.7A & 7B shall stand repealed herewith.


