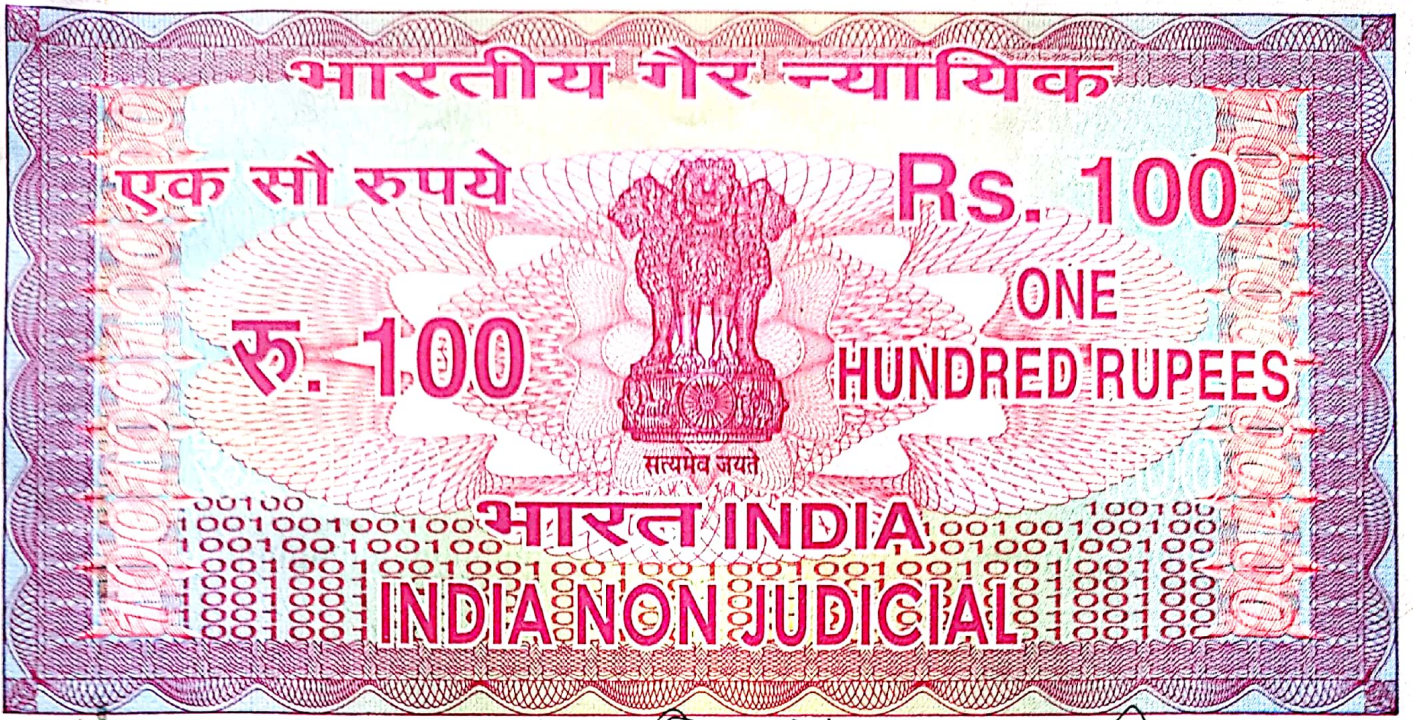

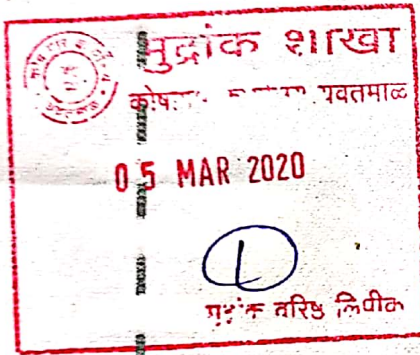

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN


JAGADAMBHA COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY, KINHI, ARNI ROAD,
YAVATMAL-445001(M.S.) here after called as party No. 1.

AND

VIDARBHA SECURITY SERVICE, SHRAMIK COLONY, WADGAON ROAD, YAVATMAL-
445001(M.S.) here after called as party No. 2.

This agreement made and entered into on the day 07/02/2020 between Party No.1 and Party No.2.
Following terms and conditions will be decided between us and will be followed by both of us which will be
legally binding on us in case of any dispute.

- 1) The guard provided by Party No.2 will report on duty, 15 minute before the duty time and will take charge of his duty from previous guard. Both of them will create the document in writing for handover of charge with their comments and will sign in register.
- 2) The guard after completion of his duty time will stay at least 15 minutes to hand over his charge to his reliever and will help to maintain the document in writing for change of charge as mention in point no.1.
- 3) Party No. 2 will provide proper uniform on duty time in college campus.
- 4) The period of contract will be valid for one year from the date of execution.
- 5) The security staff will be responsible for any theft mishap during and after college working hours.
- 6) Salary expenses will be paid by Party No.1 to Party No.2.
- 7) Party No.2 will be responsible for all other allowances and facilities to his staff including PF and incentive if any as applicable as per policy of party No.2.
- 8) Additional security guard services as and when required by party No. 1 should be made available by the agency and expenses for the same will be paid by party No.1.
- 9) Dispute if any will be subject to Yavatmal jurisdiction only.
- 10) CCTV camera footage will be verified by institution at any time for monitoring the work of security guard provided by party No. 2.
- 11) In case if Party No.1 is not satisfied with the work of security agency for whatsoever may be the reason this contract will be subject to termination on prior intimation of 15 days to party no.2 by party no.1





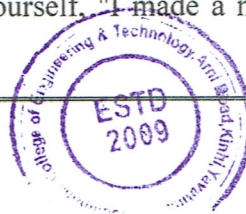
Counseling Report

Ramyya Kannan who is Expert and professional counselor interacted with the students . As the low self-esteem can negatively affect virtually every facet of student life to improve self esteem Ramyya Kannan Madam has focused on the following

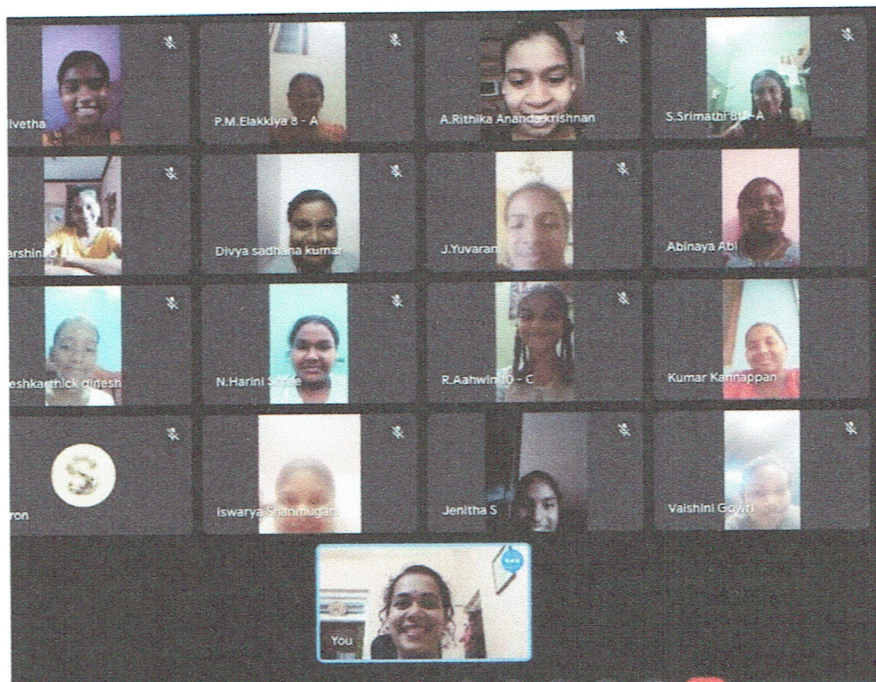
Identify troubling conditions or situations, Become aware of thoughts and beliefs Also Use hopeful statements. Treat yourself with kindness and encouragement. Instead of thinking your presentation won't go well, try telling yourself things such as, "Even though it's tough, I can handle this situation."

Forgive yourself. Everyone makes mistakes -and mistakes aren't permanent reflections on you as a person. They're isolated moments in time. Tell yourself, "I made a mistake, but that doesn't



make me a bad person." Avoid 'should' and 'must' statements. If you find that your thoughts are full of these words, you might be putting unreasonable demands on yourself — or on others. Removing these words from your thoughts can lead to more realistic expectations. Madam has given more importance on to Focus on the positive. Think about the parts of your life that work well. Consider the skills you've used to cope with challenging situations. Consider what you've learned. If it was a negative experience, what might you do differently the next time to create a more positive outcome? Avoid reliable upsetting thoughts. You don't need to react negatively to negative thoughts. Instead, think of negative thoughts as signals to try new, healthy patterns. Ask yourself, "What can I think and do to make this less stressful?" Madam has encouraged yourself. Give yourself credit for making positive changes. For example, "My presentation might not have been perfect, but my colleagues asked questions and remained engaged — which means that I accomplished my goal."

Considering the all above points Madam has interacted with all the girl students. This session was very useful and knowledgeable for the students..
